4. Fire Chief's Report

The new Ladder Truck will be picked up next Wednesday and Tinley Park will service the truck prior to delivery. Trustee Brunello had inquired about insurance for the new truck the cost to be insured for \$250. The cost of the Truck will be \$10 (Ten dollars) to the District. Ladder testing will cost \$250 to \$1,000 yearly.

Engine 117 is listed through the OSF for sale.

Engine 110 is at Fire Service for service and will require pump repair at a cost of approximately \$900.

The Fire Association has donated a sprayer for the lawn mower.

The Fireman's Association will also be purchasing cabinets for the shop area.

5. Old Business

Chief Shronts spoke to the cell tower triangulation issue that has routed calls to the Lake County Indiana 911 center versus the Kankakee County 911 center. Lake County has placed a telephone line between Lake County (11 and Kankakee County 911 to attempt to rectify the problem.

Trustee Rademacher has not been able to have a conversation with Bob Melkowski regarding the Village of Grant Park's portion of the monies for the old Fire Station. Trustee Rademacher has spoken with Tom Gilbert the Fire Protection District's attorney regarding this issue to apprise him of the situation.

On June 10th GPFDP will be doing a joint training with Beecher

June 18th will be the graduation of the Fire Academy. GPFDP will be graduating four (4) members.

The DC is developing a Candidate orientation program.

Lt. Schmidt and the DC has been working on a recruitment and retention program for the District.

The CAD system is 90% installed and should go live by the middle of June.

The new Zoll cardiac monitor will go into service tomorrow.

Lt. Schmidt has submitted for reimbursement of \$150 for Instructor I class.

The front tires on the Brush Truck need to be replaced. They are not rated for a ¾ ton pickup.

The Union Pacific Railroad has invited 5 members of the GPFDP to training in Pueblo, Colorado at no cost to the District.

Chief Shronts spoke about the Chief's Meeting with Dr. Danna and the Inspire Award given by Presence St. Mary's Hospital.
